Regional FLL Competition

On Saturday 18th November the Sussex Smashers participated in the regional FLL competition. The Sussex Smashers team is made up of Mim Macdonell, Michael Blundell, Lachlan Hollier, Lilli Stiff-Marr, Lucas Solari, Dylan Hollier and Natalie Macdonell.

FLL stands for First Lego League, First is a not for profit company aiming to educate people about robotics and there is also FRC which stands for First Robot Competition.

On the day there were around 16 teams participating. There are four sections to get judged on. First we had one of our robot games in which we program an EV3 robot to complete certain missions, our score was 90 points. Then we had our project judging, in the project we sang our song and showed them our invention. Then we had the judging of the core values which is based on how we work as a team. Then we had the robot design judging in which they ask us how the robot works, how you built it and how the attachments click on and off of the robot. Then we had the last two robot games, we scored 45 and then 20 points.

At the end of the day we had the presentation, we got the award for the Robot Design and came 2nd overall which means we have made it to nationals at Macquarie University on December 2nd & 3rd.
