

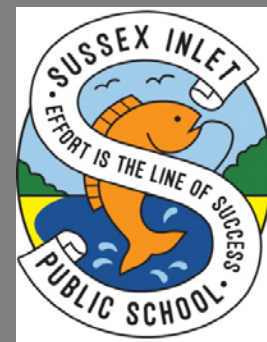

Additional Primary Class

Sussex Inlet Public School has increased and maintained student numbers to be eligible to employ an additional teacher for the remainder of the 2017 school year.

With large class sizes in our Stage 2 and Stage 3 rooms, the most logical decision is to form a new class so that student numbers are lower in each room.

The day we will begin the additional class will be Monday 31 July. The new class will be taught by Mr Dean Lannen and will be known as 3L. It will be located in Room 6 of D Block. Mr Lannen is well known and well respected by our students.

To be able to form this additional class, some students in current rooms will need to move. At this stage of the year, students are settled in their rooms and we would like to keep those students having to move to a minimum.

All Year 3 students from 3/4D will move into 3L, making Mr Douglass' class a straight Year 4 (4D). Eight year threes from 2/3B will move to the new 3L class and six year fours from 4/5R will move into the new 4D.

Having an additional class is a nice problem to have. I know that your child is probably settled in their current room. However, to move students so that all classes have smaller numbers is a better long term educational decision. Students will have more room to move in their classrooms, and teachers will be able to give more individual attention to students.
