**Tournament of Minds**

This Sunday August 26<sup>th</sup>, our two Tournament of Minds teams will travel to the University of Wollongong to compete in the Tournament of Minds regional final. This is a competition where teams of seven students present an answer to an open-ended creative thinking challenge in a ten minute dramatic performance. This year our teams have chosen to compete in the STEM and the Arts categories.

Our STEM team consists of Isabelle Harris, Lucas Solari, Matilda Goodwin, Ana Pousini, Blake Jones, Mason Barnett, and Charlotte Macdonell. Our STEM team have had to design a working model of an animal that is a hybrid of three different species and demonstrate how their model moves, eats and makes noise. They must also include a video showing where the strange new creature was found and how it has adapted from the unique environment it was found in.

Our Arts team consists of Olivia Crehan, Emily McNeil, Dylan Hollier, Marlin Webber, Darcy Stewart, Melodie Buchanan and Faith Nevin. Their challenge was to create a musical based on the theme of 'Freedom' that includes a song from the 1960's, a dance from the 1920's, art from the 1940's and fashion from the 1980's.

**WEEK 6**

NAPLAN is moving from a paper based test to online (computer based assessment) and as part of this transition during week 6 this term, students from year 3, 5, 7 & 9 will be participating in the NAPLAN Online School Readiness test.

The school readiness test is a 'practice run' for schools to assess their technology ahead of NAPLAN Online. The readiness test is not an assessment of student ability.

The readiness test allows schools to:

- become familiar with the NAPLAN Online test format and processes
- check whether they have the technical capacity, rooms and devices to administer NAPLAN Online
- provide students in NAPLAN years 3, 5 with the opportunity to experience the online test question types and format by completing a practice NAPLAN online test.
