## School uniforms

The wearing of school uniforms by students helps build self-confidence and a sense of connection with their community.

The wearing of a school uniform creates a sense of collective and individual pride in our school as well as giving our students a sense of belonging. Equality is fostered by a uniform policy common to all students. Compulsory uniforms assist in eliminating peer group pressure to wear less appropriate clothing, reduces competition amongst children and removes pressure on families to provide “fashionable” items for daily wear.

**Looking around the playground lately, I am very disappointed with the various versions of our uniform.** Our school uniform was developed in collaboration with parents and the community and their expectations are that all students will wear the SIPS uniform. A reminder of our uniform requirements:

### GIRLS UNIFORM

#### Summer Uniform

- blue and white check dress
- blue & white check culottes
- blue culottes
- light blue polo shirt
- white socks, black shoes
- blue sun hat

#### Winter Uniform

- light blue skivvy or polo shirt
- blue culottes
- blue pants
- school jumper or jacket
- white socks or navy tights, black shoes
- blue sun hat

### Sports Uniform

- royal blue pleated skirt/blue skorts/shorts
- school sports shirt
- navy blue track suit
- microfibre track suit
- white socks, sports shoes

Nail polish is NOT to be worn. Earrings are to be ‘sleepers’ or non-dangling, due to injury in general play.

### BOYS UNIFORM

#### Summer Uniform

- grey shorts
- light blue polo shirt
- grey socks, black shoes
- blue sun hat

#### Winter Uniform

- grey trousers
- light blue polo shirt
- school jumper or jacket
- grey socks, black shoes
- blue sun hat

### Sports Uniform

- royal blue shorts
- school sports shirt
- navy blue track suit
- microfibre track suit
- white socks, sports shoes
