Request from the NSW Rural Fire Service/Ambulance

Increasingly over the last 12 months we have noticed that parents have been using the Sussex Inlet Rural Fire Brigade/Ambulance Services parking area when attending school assemblies and dropping off/picking up their children. This creates a potentially dangerous situation for them, particularly the students because when we receive incident callouts, we can have as many as 12-15 vehicles requiring parking. Plus we could have up to three appliances needing to respond to an emergency. Response time for us is critical.

You may find that your car will receive a fine or be towed away, so parents we are asking you to refrain from using the Rural Fire Brigade/Ambulance Services parking area. We need those areas kept clear.
