

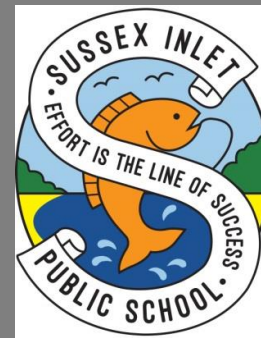

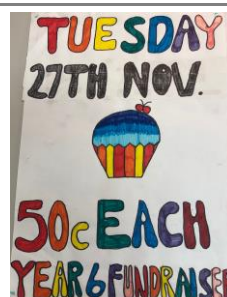

Robotics Competition

On Saturday, 17th November our school robotics team, Sussex Storm, competed in their first robotics competition at Ulladulla High School. The team consisted of Riley Kennedy, Jed McDowall, Bella Lord, Blake Jones, T-Jay Campton, Maddison Austin, Melodie Buchanan, Lani Richardson, Payton McDonagh and Mia Bradbury. Students have been working on their coding and robotics skills throughout Term 3 and Term 4 to prepare for the competition and were also required to present research on an idea that could make space travel easier for astronauts. Students designed a 3D printer that astronauts could use to turn the plastic from their packaging and rubbish into new items such as cutlery, tools and clothing. Our team were given the Tournament Director's award for never giving up for the persistence and dedication they showed in overcoming challenges in the three rounds of the robot game to achieve a team personal best score in the final round of competition.



Circus Incursion

Year Six students with an interest in gymnastics and performing arts were given the opportunity to participate in a live virtual incursion to meet the performers of the School Spectacular "The Greatest 2018" show. Our students recorded a video of themselves asking the cast members questions which was then played for students watching across the state. The students were able to listen to the performers respond to their questions and learnt about the training required to perform at that level and the practice involved with putting together a performance of so many students.
