Dear Parent and Carers

The Department of Education has stated in their Road Safety Policy that, "We recommend principals do not allow parents and carers to drive onto the school site to pick up or drop off students".

We have limited car parking spaces in the staff car park, please could we remind that parents/visitors to our school, park on the road and not drive or walk through the staff car park to enter the school grounds. We encourage you to teach your children to walk along the pathways and use the school crossing whenever possible.

The staff car park is not to be used as a pick up and set down point for children, nor are to be used as thoroughfares. Children are not allowed to enter the car park as it is a hazardous area with cars moving in and out. This also applies to parents accessing the Before & After School Care.
