Premier's Reading Challenge

Sussex Inlet Public School will participate in this year's Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC) and all students will have the opportunity to be involved. The PRC aims to encourage in students a love of reading and enable them to experience quality literature. It is not a competition, but a challenge to each student to read; to read more and to read a wide variety of texts.



The Challenge opens on Monday 4th March, 2019 and runs until Friday 30th August, 2019. Students are encouraged to start recording their books for this year ready for entry onto the PRC database when registration opens on 4th March.

K-2 students need to experience a minimum of thirty (30) books with at least twenty five (25) of these being approved PRC books. Students in years 3-6 are required to read and record twenty (20) books in total with a minimum of fifteen (15) being from the PRC book lists. Students completing the Challenge will receive a PRC certificate.

If any parent/carer objects to their child participating in the 2019 Premier's Reading Challenge please advise the school as soon as possible.

Students who complete four (4) challenges receive a Gold Award and those who complete seven (7) challenges a Platinum Award.

SIPS have a large selection of PRC books in our Library and will encourage all students to participate. Students will be able to borrow at least one PRC book each time they visit the Library during class lessons. K-2 students will have some books read to them by their class teachers. Students in years 3-6 will be encouraged to complete the Challenge independently; however teachers and staff will always be available to help.

Active Kids and Creative Kids are programs designed to encourage more children to participate in sport, active recreation and creative and cultural activities.

Each year, parents, guardians and carers can receive a \$100 voucher to go towards both creative and physical activities for school aged children. That's \$200 worth of savings per year for each child.
