**Woolworths Earn & Learn**

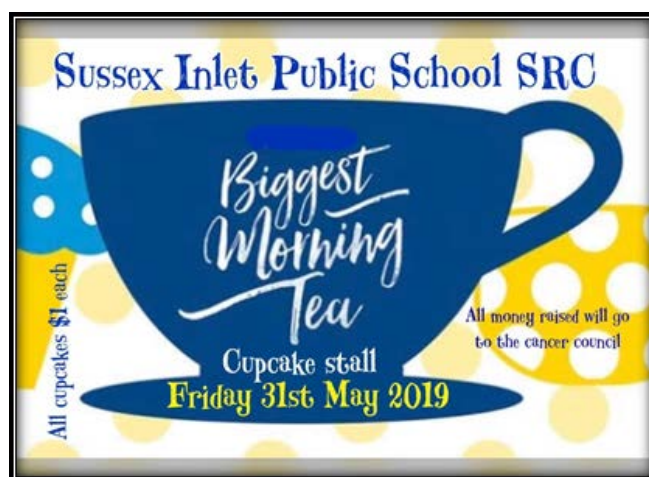

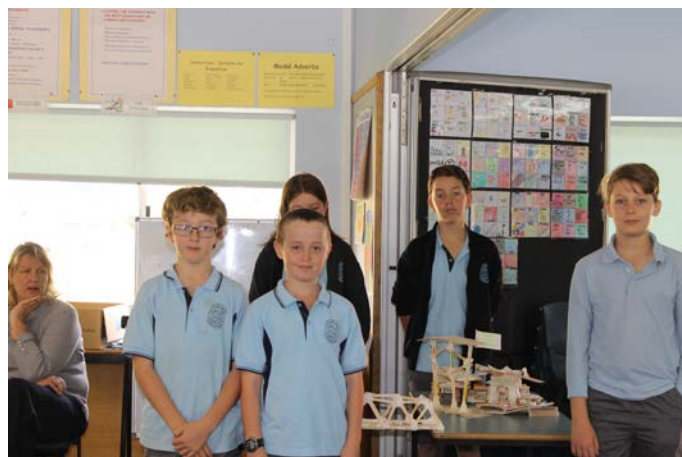


**SRC Biggest Morning Tea**
