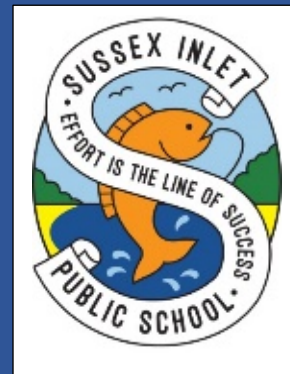

Do you have a favourite character?

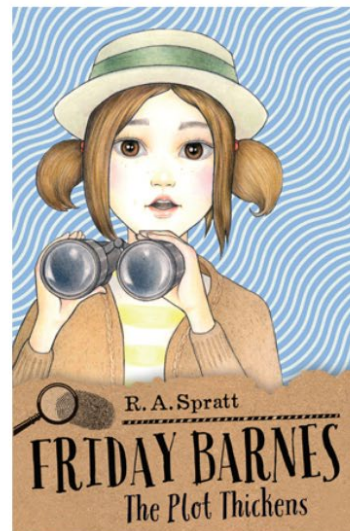
Friday Barnes, the main character.
